At Whitehorn Community Transition Home, located in northeast Calgary, Child & Youth Development Counsellors provide care for children and youth with Child Welfare status aged 7-17. Child & Youth Development Counsellors, working a rotation of varied shifts (day, afternoon and evening), are responsible for providing day to day physical and emotional care for youth, while participating in planning for provision of services and care in the future.

Responsibilities:

- Develop and maintain respectful and appropriate relationships with program clients
- Daily documentation as well as formal reporting as required by program
- Care and attention towards maintaining a comfortable home like living environment
- Provide a healthy and appropriate role model for youth
- Apply knowledge of child development and strategies in working with children and youth to support increased resiliency and personal capacity
