We have an exciting opportunity for a Community Outreach Worker with the Community Connections Program to support residents in actively contributing to positive changes in their neighbourhoods. This includes supporting families and communities to develop a strong sense of empowerment, ability to make positive decisions and working to eliminate and reduce the impact of poverty. Community Outreach Workers assist individuals and families to access basic needs, provide financial literacy support and engage with residents to build supportive relationships in the community. Some evening and weekend work is required.

- Provide longer term support to individuals, families, and groups to build upon existing assets and achievement in goal-setting
- Provide financial literacy support to residents to increase financial capability
- Connect residents to community assets and activities to facilitate the development of supportive relationships and connection to their communities
- Connect and support access to community services and resources
- Utilize the roles of advocate, broker, educator and facilitator to support individuals/families
- Complete documentation and outcome measures
